

Students' Evaluation of Teaching

Courses Taught and Normative Data

Over the last decade, Professor Phillips has been responsible for teaching numerous sections of the first undergraduate accounting course (Comm 201) as well as two courses in the Master of Professional Accounting (MPAcc) program. The evaluation forms used in these courses have varied over the years. In 2007-2011, student evaluations were elicited using the Student Evaluation of Educational Quality (SEEQ) survey, which is voluntarily and anonymously completed by students online at the end of each semester prior to the department head approving final course grades. Prior to 2007, undergraduate and MPAcc student evaluations were elicited by college-approved forms, which used different ratings scales. For ease of comparison, overall instructor evaluations before 2007 are summarized as a percent of the scale maximum score. Student evaluations are not tabulated for the two undergraduate financial accounting courses that Fred taught while on leave at the University of Texas at Austin during 2006-2007 and 2002-2003. His overall ratings in those courses were 93 and 94 percent of the scale maximum, respectively.
